



2019 Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) information: Updated February 28, 2020

Guest safety, health, comfort, and enjoyment are at the heart of everything we do. Our staff and partners are regularly monitoring information disseminated by the CDC (US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention) and WHO (World Health Organization) as well as local agencies. While the statistical risk of contracting the virus remains low worldwide, we will continue to assess the situation as more information becomes available.

Many of our trips are conducted in remote areas far from professional medical attention. We don't want anyone to be in a position in which they need medical attention in an area where it is not readily available. Current information indicates that although the virus can be present with minimal or no symptoms, those most at risk are older and younger patients with other underlying health issues.

In order to reduce the risk to our customers and crew members further, we ask that certain prospective guests do not travel with us at this time, both for ease of travel through international airports and the safety of other guests and crew. Those guests include:

- Those with a fever
- Those who are experiencing other respiratory symptoms such as shortness of breath or breathing difficulties
- Those who within the 15 days prior to boarding have traveled through, or suspects they have had in-person contact with a person who has traveled through an area with a large number of coronavirus cases, such as Hubei Province in China or other regions that are affected.
- Those who have had contact in the last 15 days with someone with a suspected or confirmed COVID-19 infection

Our crews are briefed on additional procedures should a guest develop symptoms during charter. While cleanliness is always a priority for vessel crew, additional disinfection protocols are being implemented. In addition to crew efforts, guests will be briefed aboard about current WHO advice to minimize risks of illness transmission:
